BRIEF ITINERARY:

DAY 0: Arrive in Delhi (Kashmere Gate) by 9 PM, meet the rest of the Jungles, and begin the over-night drive to Shimla in a semi-sleeper AC Volvo.

DAY 1: After breakfast & freshen up, start off the adventure by visiting Hatu Peak in Shimla, visit Hatu Temple, and continue onward to Rakchham / Sangla for an evening by the Baspa River!

DAY 2: Wake up in Rakchham / Sangla to the soothing Baspa River, explore the last village of Chitkul with a fun stop at Hindustan Ka Akhri Dhaba, and journey onward to Kalpa for a cozy evening beneath the majestic "Kinner Kailash range!"

DAY 3: Say Hello to golden views of the Kinner Kailash in Kalpa, visit Suicide Point, then journey into Spiti Valley with scenic stops at Khab Sangam (confluence of two rivers), Nako Lake, and Gue monastery (500 year old mummy), before reaching Tabo for the night!

DAY 4: Today, explore the ancient and serene Tabo Monastery, then drive through the rugged landscapes of Spiti Valley to the lively town of Kaza, with a refreshing stop at the scenic Lingti Waterfall before ending the day exploring its charming local markets!

DAY 5: It's Good morning to the high altitude gems of Spiti Valley, visit Hikkim (world's highest post office), the surreal village of Komic, pass by the wild terrains of Kibber Wildlife Sanctuary, and explore Langza's iconic Buddha statue before returning back to our stay in Kaza

DAY 6: Start early from Kaza and visit the iconic hilltop Key Monastery, then drive via the high-altitude Kunzum Pass to the spectacular Chicham Bridge, and continue to the mesmerizing Chandratul Lake for a magical evening while we stargaze & capture the clearest Milky Way of our lives!

DAY 7: After an early start, journey from the rugged heights via the majestic Kunzum Pass, Solang Valley and the engineering marvel of Atal Tunnel to the vibrant hill town of Manali, where you can unwind with café hopping and an evening stroll along the lively Mall Road

DAY 8: Wake up and explore Manali at your own pace, soaking in the last moments, seek blessings at the great Hadimba temple and visit the old Manali before driving back to Delhi.

DAY 9: Reach Delhi by 8 AM in the morning on the next day! Until next time, Jungles!

DAY 0: THE JOURNEY BEGINS!

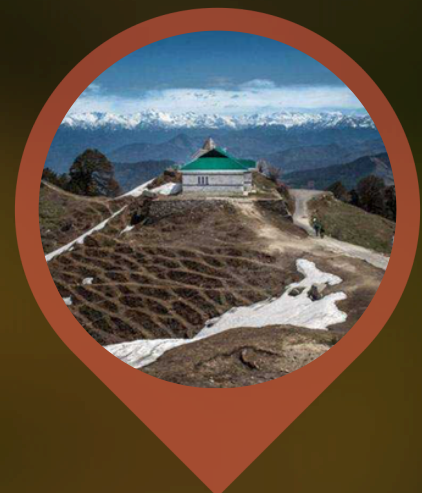

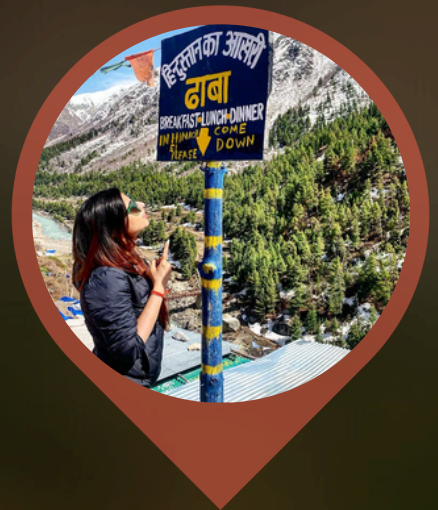

KALPA (KINNAUR VALLEY)



DAY 3: KALPA TO TABO VIA NAKO & GUE

- Wake up to mesmerizing views of the majestic Kinner Kailash, believed to be the summer abode of Lord Shiva.
- The golden sunrise illuminating the peaks creates a truly divine and unforgettable start to your day in Kalpa.
- After breakfast, visit the famous Suicide Point, known for its dramatic cliffs and breathtaking valley views. Soon after, begin your journey toward Tabo, entering the rugged landscapes of Spiti.
- En route, stop at the stunning Khab Sangam, where the Spiti River meets the Sutlej River, creating a striking natural confluence.
- Continue to the serene Nako Lake, a peaceful high-altitude lake perfect for a short break.
- Further ahead, visit Gue, home to the 500-year-old naturally preserved mummy of Buddhist monk Stanzin Sangha.
- By evening, arrive in Tabo, check into your stay, enjoy a warm dinner, and settle in for a peaceful overnight stay.

- Soon after, drive toward Kaza, the bustling headquarters and heart of Spiti Valley.
- En route, stop by the beautiful Lingti Waterfall, where cascading waters amidst barren mountains create a refreshing sight.
- Arrive in Kaza by late evening and take some time to explore the local market.
- Stroll through quaint lanes, discover cozy cafes, and pick up souvenirs that reflect the unique culture of Spiti.
- As the day winds down, return to your hotel for a delicious dinner and relax with an overnight stay in the heart of Spiti.

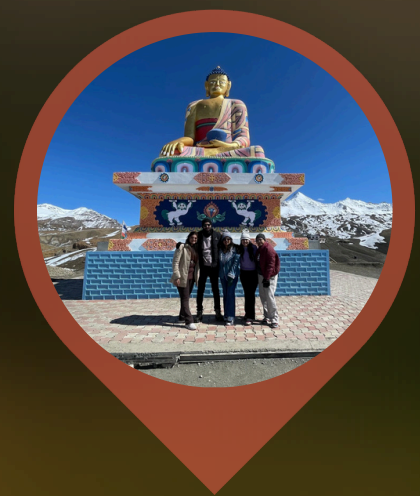


KAZA (HEART OF SPITI VALLEY)



DAY 5: LOCAL SIGHTSEEING IN SPITI VALLEY (HIKKIM, KOMIC & LANGZA)

- After breakfast, set out to explore the very best of Spiti Valley, a land of dramatic landscapes and high-altitude wonders.
- Your first stop is Hikkim, home to the world's highest post office. Don't miss the chance to send handwritten postcards to your loved ones from this unique location.
- Next, head to Komic, one of the highest motorable villages in the world, offering surreal views and a peaceful Himalayan vibe.
- On the way, pass through the region near Kibber Wildlife Sanctuary, famously known as a snow leopard spotting zone aka "the ghost of the mountains!"
- Continue onward to Langza, a picturesque village famous for its ancient marine fossils, remnants of a time when this region was under the sea. Try your luck at spotting one!
- Also visit the iconic Buddha statue overlooking the valley, adding to the spiritual charm of the place.
- By evening, return to Kaza. Spend your time exploring the lively local market, hopping between cozy cafes, and indulging in delicious food before heading back to your stay for dinner and a comfortable overnight stay.

DAY 6: KAZA TO CHANDRATAL LAKE VIA KEY MONASTERY & CHICHAM BRIDGE

- Start your day early, check out, and head toward the iconic Key Monastery, perched at an altitude of 13,668 ft.
- This centuries-old monastery offers breathtaking views of the valley and a peaceful atmosphere, take some time to interact with the monks and experience their way of life.
- Next, drive toward the spectacular Chicham Bridge via the high-altitude Kunzum Pass.
- Standing tall above a deep gorge, this is one of the highest bridges in the world and an engineering marvel set amidst dramatic landscapes.
- Continue your journey to the mesmerizing Chandratal Lake, also known as the “Moon Lake,” located at an altitude of around 4,200 meters. Surrounded by stark mountains, watch the lake shift its colors from crystal blue to emerald green as the sun sets, an unforgettable sight.
- By evening, settle into your camps near Chandratal or head toward Losar for dinner and an overnight stay

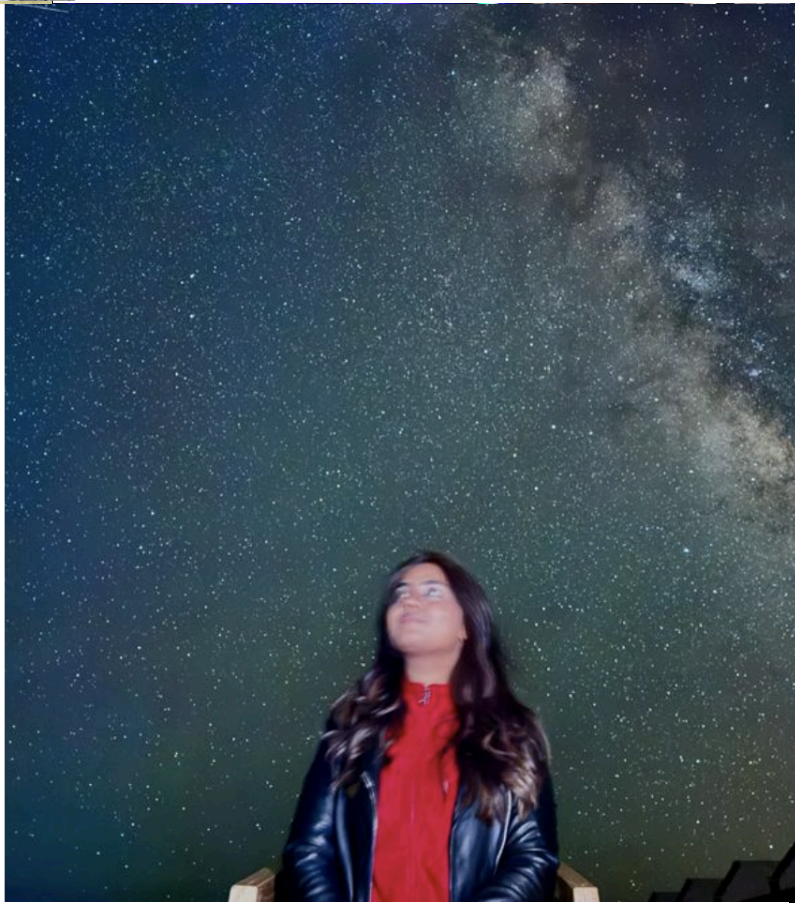




NOTES:

- Do NOT carry big Suitcases or heavy luggage, a good Backpack is recommended and would be comfortable to carry.
- It's a Backpacking Trip and not a Luxury trip, the trip will be on a decent comfort basis & not luxury and this is how we would be fully able to taste the local culture as well as get a hang of backpacking!
- For meals that are not on the house, we will recommend the most famous & best restaurants / Cafés around Himachal / Spiti (Budget around Rs 200 per meal)
- Early check-in / late check-out is strictly subject to availability.
- We will be staying in at all places on triple sharing basis with clean attached washrooms at our camps / hotel (one of the best & central locations).
- Any cost arising out of any event beyond our control, like, a strike, bandh, riot, train cancellation, flight cancellation, mechanical breakdown, or natural calamity like heavy rains, landslides, snowfall, or earthquakes, will be directly borne by the guest.
- Any flight / train tickets are not included in the cost.
- Aim to arrive in Delhi (Kashmere Gate) by 9 pm on Day 0 & we'll reach back to Delhi at 8 am on Day 9 (please keep 3-4 hours for buffer time while bookings your return journey)
- Any extra cost for appliances like heater, tv, oven, etc are not included in the package cost.
- It gets quite cold since we're going into a high-altitude region. Therefore acclimatization is must. That is why our itinerary is designed accordingly that the altitude increases gradually! Do carry a pair of thermals if you're sensitive to cold. Cozy, warm blankets will be provided at all these places.
- Do get a small day pack (Decathlon 10 L bag) to carry your essentials while we go exploring on most days, quite handy!
- Get a refillable water bottle, dry fruits & a lot of munchies for the trip. We wanna reduce plastic waste as much as possible :)
- For stargazing: We're actually going to have a professional astronomer on board (Mr. Sandip Bedekar), he is the best person to join with when it comes to stargazing, coming with 22+ years of experience leading such trips!
- There's a fair bit of traveling involved throughout the trip (5-6 hrs per day) Sometimes its lesser. However, the roads are in great condition almost everywhere.
- We're traveling to Spiti during the peak stargazing season, So be prepared for the best stargazing experience of your lives!
