DAY 4: Set out to explore the hidden gem of Turtuk, a charming border village known for its lush greenery, traditional homes, and try the seasonal apricot fruits. Experience the unique Balti culture and enjoy scenic views of the Shyok River flowing through the valley.

DAY 5: Drive towards the magical Pangong Tso, famous for its ever-changing shades of blue. Relax by the serene lake and enjoy the stargazing experience at night

DAY 6: Wake up to Pangong's beauty and journey towards the remote village of Hanle via the historic Chusul War Memorial. Visit the world-class Indian Astronomical Observatory, one of the highest in the world & reach Hanle via Umling La Pass, the world's highest motorable road!

DAY 7: Visit the serene Hanle Monastery. Drive back towards Leh. If time permits, visit Druk Padma Karpo School ("3 Idiots School") and the surreal Lamayuru Monastery. Evening is free to explore the Cafes & local market of Le!

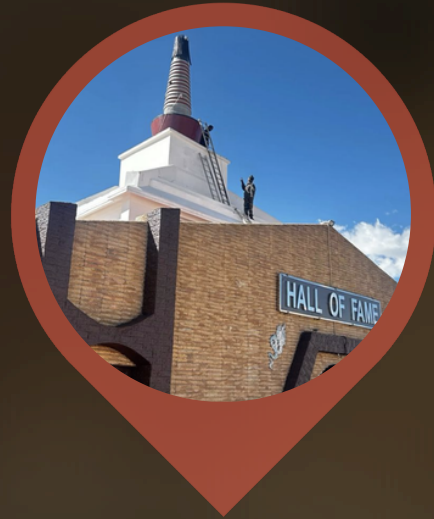


LEH & SHAM VALLEY

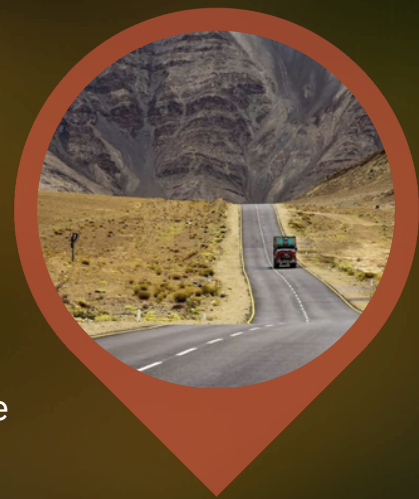


HALL OF FAME MUSEUM

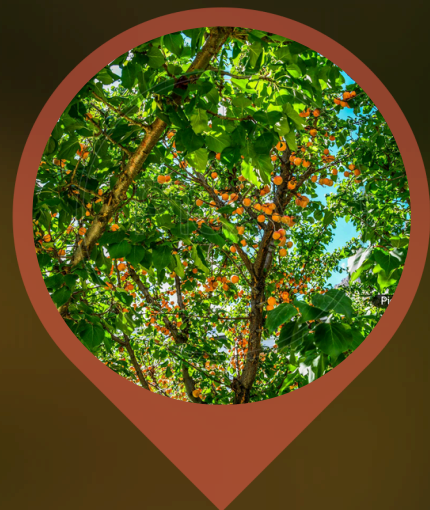
TURTUK - LAST MAJOR VILLAGE BEFORE LOC!

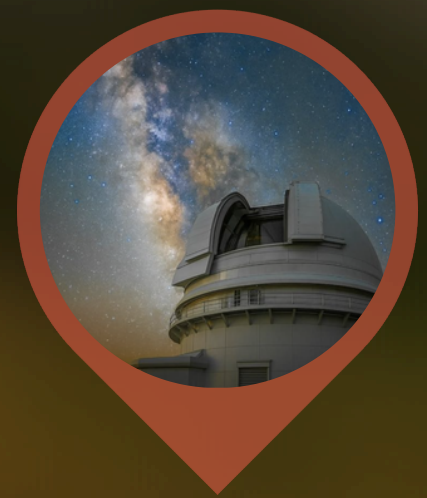

DAY 6: STARGAZING AT THE DARKEST SKIES IN THE WORLD - HANLE!!

- After a night under the starry skies and waking up to the serene beauty of Pangong Lake, enjoy an early breakfast.
- Spend some time exploring the lake's breathtaking surroundings.
- Embark on a journey towards India's Dark Sky Reserve at Hanle, stopping at the historic Chusul War Memorial
- Visit the Indian Astronomical Observatory, home to the Himalayan Chandra Telescope, perched at 14,760 feet.
- At night, witness the Bortle 1 sky (Hanle lies in a designated Dark Sky Reserve, meaning almost zero light pollution. The night sky here is among the darkest in the world, making stars, planets, and even the Milky Way visible to the naked eye!)
- Head towards Hanle via Umling La Pass, the world's highest motorable road surrounded by vast, untouched landscapes.
- Enjoy a stargazing session with our telescope & professional astronomer, who has experience of more than 22 years!
- Overnight stay at Hanle, surrounded by unmatched natural beauty and starlit skies.

NOTES:

- Do NOT carry big Suitcases or heavy luggage, a good Backpack is recommended and would be comfortable to carry.
- It's a Backpacking Trip and not a Luxury trip, the trip will be on a decent comfort basis & not luxury and this is how we would be fully able to taste the local culture as well as get a hang of backpacking!
- For meals that are not on the house, we will recommend the most famous & best restaurants / Cafés around Ladakh (Budget around Rs 200 per meal)
- Early check-in / late check-out is strictly subject to availability.
- We will be staying in at all places on triple sharing basis with clean attached washrooms at our camps / hotel (one of the best & central locations).
- Any cost arising out of any event beyond our control, like, a strike, bandh, riot, train cancellation, flight cancellation, mechanical breakdown, or natural calamity like heavy rains, landslides, snowfall, or earthquakes, will be directly borne by the guest.
- Flight tickets to and from Leh are not included in the cost.
- Aim to arrive in Leh on Day 1 by 11 AM latest, and for your return flight on the last day, please book a flight departing after 11 AM.
- Any extra cost for appliances like heater, tv, oven, etc are not included in the package cost.
- It gets quite cold since we're going into a high-altitude region. Therefore acclimatization is must. That is why our itinerary is designed accordingly that the altitude increases gradually! Do carry a pair of thermals if you're sensitive to cold. Cozy, warm blankets will be provided at all these places.
- Do get a small day pack (Decathlon 10 L bag) to carry your essentials while we go exploring on most days, quite handy!
- Get a refillable water bottle, dry fruits & a lot of munchies for the trip. We wanna reduce plastic waste as much as possible :)
- We're actually going to have a professional astronomer on board (Mr. Sandip Bedekar), he is the best person to join with when it comes to stargazing, coming with 22+ years of experience leading such trips!
- There's a fair bit of traveling involved throughout the trip (max 5-6 hrs per day) Sometimes its lesser. However, the roads are in good condition almost everywhere.
- We're traveling to Leh during the peak stargazing season, So be prepared for the best stargazing experience of your lives!
